Dear Parents,

Many thanks for your patience, understanding and support over the past week as we put in place measures to support you and our children over the next month.

Government announcements are changing by the day and we are currently working with other partners to ensure all our children get suitable provision during this time.

This morning, our Local Authority have announced that **for children whose parents work in any of the key services,** schools will be open as 'normal' (which includes breakfast club) on Monday and Tuesday (23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>) next week. From Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March, it is possible that childcare will move to one central school in Newtown, more details will follow.

The care is only for <u>a limited number of children</u> and the Government has asked that <u>where possible</u>, <u>children should remain at home and asked for schools to remain open only for those children who</u> <u>need it</u>. The fewer children in schools, the lower the risk that the virus can spread and infect vulnerable individuals in the wider society.

A full list of key workers is available on the Government website and includes:

- \* Health and social care
- \* Education and childcare
- \* Key public services
- \* Local and national government
- \* Food and other necessary goods
- \* Public safety and national security
- \* Transport
- \* Utilities, communication and financial services

If you haven't already done so, please contact school to let us know if you are a key worker, and whether your child(ren) would need to access school or can be looked after at home.

The Council has also identified children with specific needs who will also go to their usual school on Monday and Tuesday. School will contact you if your child(ren) has been identified in this way as soon as confirmation of the criteria has been finalised. If you think that your child will need additional support through this time, please call me and we can discuss this matter further.

For children who are entitled to <u>free school meals</u> there will be a packed lunch made available, which can be collected by midday. If you require one, could you please inform us by 10am on those days.
