The weather is getting chillier - make sure your child has a **coat** in school for outdoor activities - we like to get the children outside as much as possible for their learning.

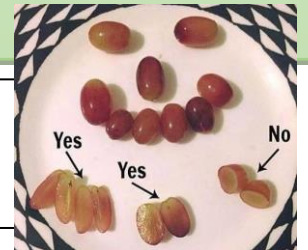

KEY REMINDERS

PARKING

Please park considerately and legally. Use spaces in the car park or the bus bay. **DO NOT** park on the pavement, or the zig-zag lines. This causes an obstruction for pedestrians, blocks visibility for those pulling out of the carpark, and narrows the road for other traffic, including the police.

UNIFORM

Please remember to put names in all coats, uniform and PE kit.
