September edges ever nearer and we are currently making final alterations to classes and across the school to ensure that we are fully prepared for the return of all our children.

We hope that the new fences around our school will be completed in the next few weeks and that our new reception and office area will provide a warm and welcoming entrance to our school.

Our Education Minister announced last week new guidance for schools which we will be working through and confirm any changes to current procedures with you in the final week of the holidays, though it is likely that we will continue to follow some of our current arrangements which we think have worked for us this year.

One area we can confirm is the start and finish times of our new school. These were approved by Governors earlier this week. Our Foundation Phase will start at 8:55am and finish at 3:05pm for all children. In Key Stage 2, all children will start at 8:55am and finish at 3:15pm. There will be no staggered start times within the Foundation Phase or Key Stage 2.
